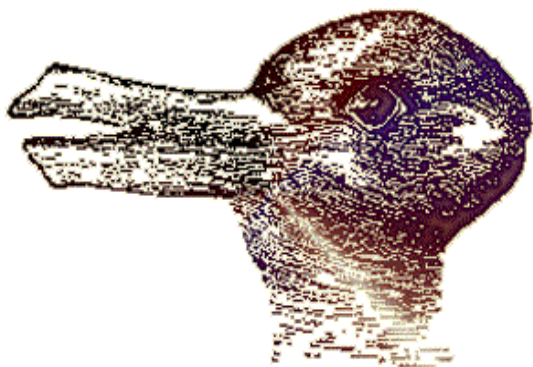

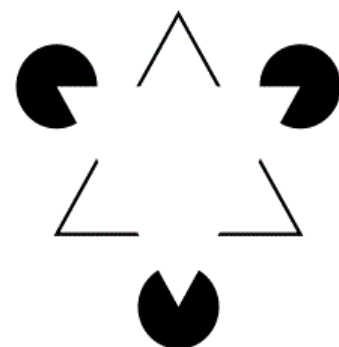
Here are some optical illusions look very carefully and what could they be. The answers are at the bottom of the page.

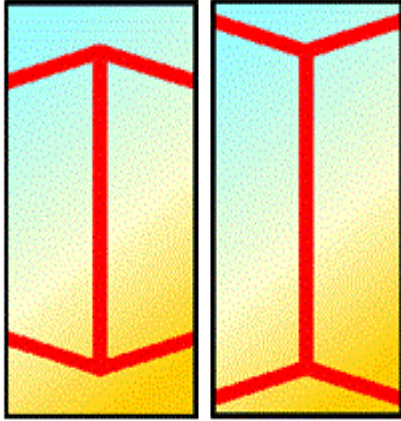
How many animals do you see in the image?

Take a very close look at the 2 verticals lines.

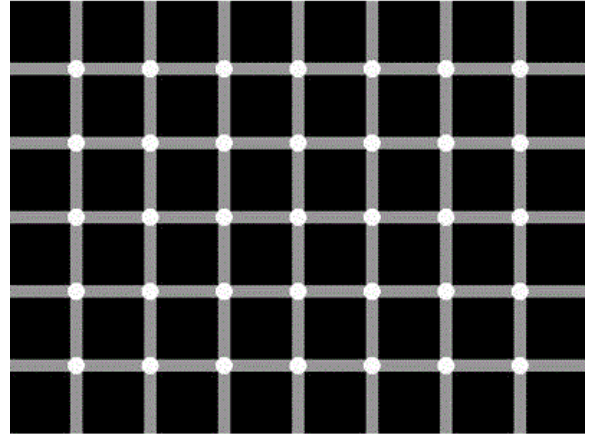
Do you think one line is longer than the other?

Answers

The animal – Look closely, you should be able to see a rabbit and a duck.

Kanizsa Triangle – In reality there are only 3 V shapes that look like Pac-men.

Muller-Lyer Illusion – They are the same size! Hard to believe, you can measure with a ruler to check.

Hermann Grid Illusion - If you focus directly on each dot, you will see that all of them are white.
