Home Learning Challenges

In the story, the animals are getting ready for their big winter sleep. This is sometimes called hibernation. Can you make a nest for a creature to sleep in? You could make it in your garden or an outside space.

The words 'Hattie' and 'hedgehog' both begin with a 'h'. What letter does your name begin with? How many other words can you think of that start with that letter?



Hattie the Hedgehog was very good at sharing. Can you find something that you could share with a brother, sister or a friend? Maybe you could let them use something of yours or play with it together.

Hattie had 5 orange leaves and 5 red leaves. How many leaves did she have altogether to build her nest? Maybe you could draw them to find out the answer.

The animals had to get ready for their big sleep. What do you need to do before you go to sleep? When you get ready for bed, talk about the things you need to do.

Can you make a picture of a hedgehog? You could paint it or draw it. Maybe you could find some spiky objects, such as sticks or pointy leaves, to use for its prickles and glue them on.
