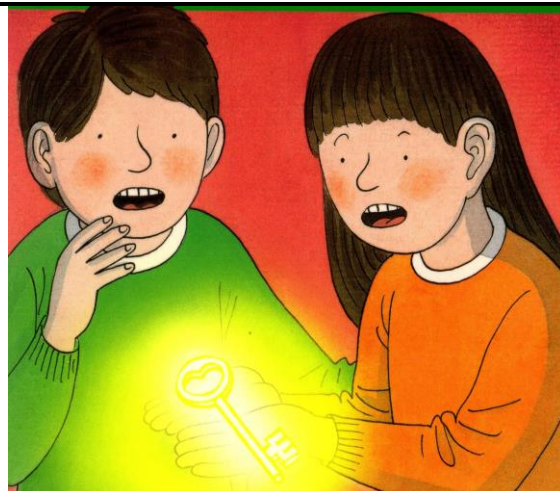

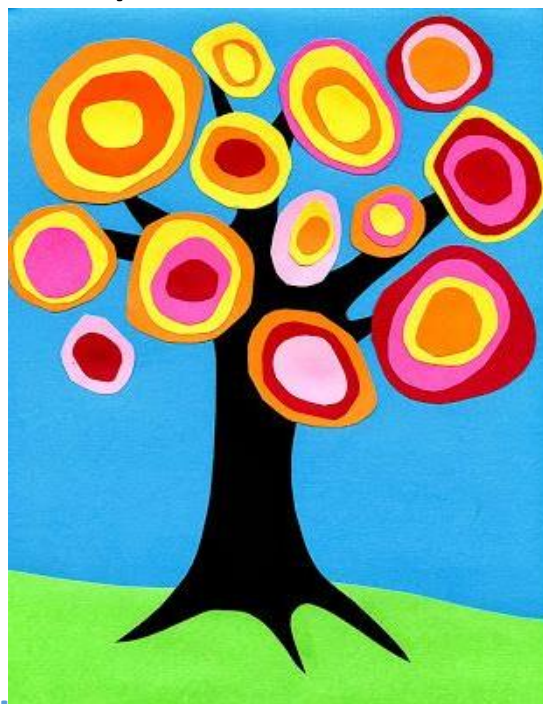
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Creative Time

Why don't you have a go at your cutting skills to create a picture like one of these (or both).



You will need a pair of scissors (Parents please supervise), different coloured paper (or colour in white paper with your crayons or colouring pencils and then cut out circles) and a glue stick or PVA glue with a spatula or paint brush to use it.

For the black silhouette tree, you can draw the outline with a pencil and then cut it out and if you find it difficult to cut different sized circles free hand then you can draw outlines of the circles before cutting them.

Then stick them on a large sheet of background paper.
