# NOTE VALUES

## *SEMIBREVE- MINIM- CROTCHET*

### SEMIBREVE

Note called **SEMIBREVE** has 4 counts or we can say 4 beats. It is like a whole **PIE** that you can eat all alone. To feel it to can say very slowly word **PIE** and count until 4 in your head. Try it now.



### MINIM



The second note we'll look at is called a **minim**. It's similar to a semibreve but has a line coming out of the right-hand side of its note head. This line is called a **stem**. It is like a **half** of the **PIE**, and you can use the word "**SAND-WICH**" to feel it. Clap your hand for each syllable of the word SANDWICH and you will get the 2 MINIMS.

*! MINIM is twice shorter/faster than SEMIBREVE*

### CROTCHET

Next, we have a **crotchet**.

It looks like a minim but it has its note head filled in black.

**Crotchet** has a value of 1 beat.

It is a **fourth** part of your **PIE**. Clap your 4 times hands and say the word **TEA** to feel it.



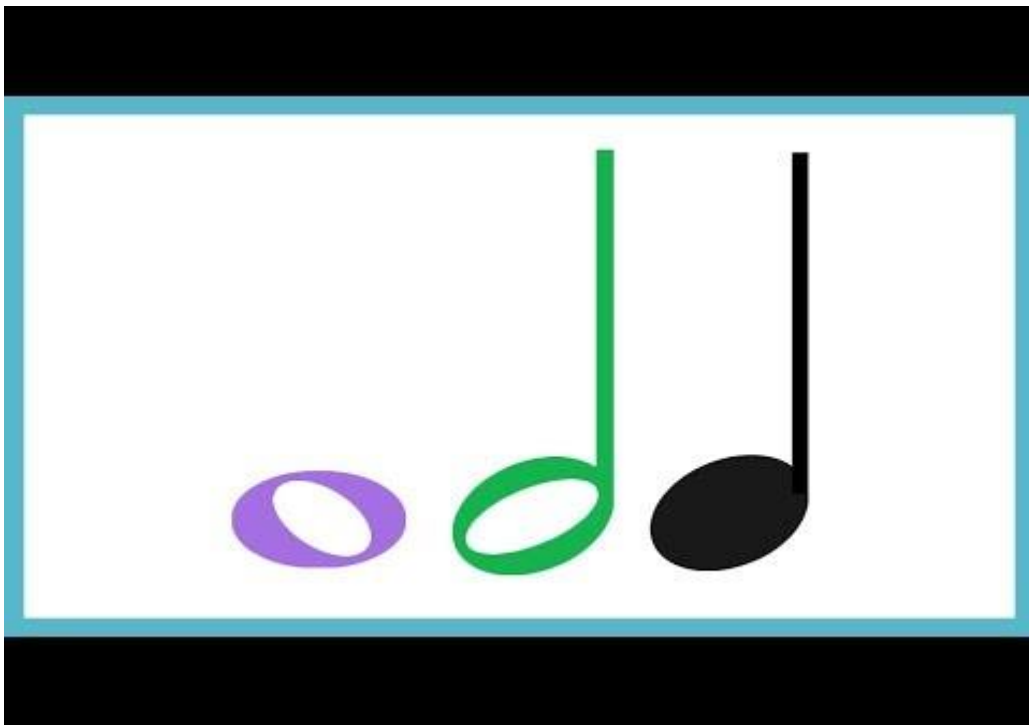
**TEA-TEA-TEA-TEA**  
**Clap-Clap-Clap-Clap**

*! CROTCHET is twice shorter/faster than the MINIM*

*! CROTCHET is four times/faster than SEMIBREVE*
